

**Paul Fink**

A 1978 graduate of the University of Michigan, Paul Fink has worked in the housing and community development field for the past 29 years, and has been executive director of the Town of Islip Community Development Agency since 1992. Acting in partnership with private and not-for-profit developers, he has been responsible for over 500 units of affordable housing, 300 storefront renovations, 100 units of family and senior rental housing, development of the Applied Technology Center business incubator and Touro College in Bay Shore, and public services for over 500 families per year. Paul has worked with investment bankers in the issuance of more than \$55 million in tax exempt bonds for CDA projects, and serves as president of Islip's Housing Development Fund Company. Paul is also a past president of the Long Island Community Development Organization, and currently serves as Vice-President for Community Development of the New York State Association of Renewal and Housing Officials. 2008 salary: \$103,100.
